Morro Mir Bahr Town Ali Akbar inspected the chalking points. He said that these chalking points had been closed for a long time, due to which rainwater used to accumulate here. He reviewed the local government facilities provided to the people of Morro Mir Bahr Town during the rains.

He asked the local government officers present on the spot He directed that the drainage of rainwater from residential areas should be ensured immediately and that no negligence should be done in the drainage of rainwater. He further said that

after the Meteorological Department predicted rains, the administration of Morro Mir Bahr Town had completed precautionary arrangements in advance, due to which no standing rainwater was seen anywhere in the town. Dewatering pumps, P.D.M.A.K. pumps and available manpower are being used for the drainage of rainwater.

Staff has been deployed to drain rainwater collected on roads and highways, which is ensuring the movement of traffic by cleaning the accumulated water from time to time.
